

# Pueblo County High School Alumni Foundation Scholarship

The Pueblo County High School Alumni Foundation was formed in 2015. One of the foundation's goals is to provide a scholarship for a graduating senior(s). An annual scholarship is awarded to a current Pueblo County High Senior(s). The scholarship will be a one-time award for the recipient. The Board of Directors will determine the amount of the scholarship(s) annually in January of the year awarded.

Eligible student applicants may attend any accredited college or university (a two or four- year institution) in the United States and will not be restricted in the field of study they want to pursue. The scholarship is nontransferable and is forfeited or terminated if the recipient changes or transfers to another college or university after the scholarship has been awarded.

Deadline for application is on or before **April 1<sup>st</sup>** and must be turned into the principal's office by 3:00 PM of the deadline date.



## Eligibility Criteria

- Current senior at Pueblo County High School eligible for graduation in May.
- GPA requirement is a 2.75 or higher on an unweighted scale.
- ACT or SAT score must be provided with the application.
- Student must have applied to an accredited U.S. college or university as a full-time student (minimum 12 credit hours per term) and must be accepted at the accredited college or university before the scholarship will be awarded.
- Parent/legal guardian and/or grandparent must be an *active donor* of the Pueblo County High Alumni Foundation. (An active donor is defined as a person who made a monetary contribution of \$25 or more posted by December 31st of the previous calendar year.)
- Completed application.
- Completed required essay must accompany the application.
- A current unofficial/official transcript including seven semesters completed to date.
- Three current letters of recommendation that must come from a counselor, other school personnel, and a community member. Letters should not come from the designated Alumni donor.
- Scholarship recipient(s) will be notified on or before April 30th. Recipient(s) is required to provide all contact information of the higher education institution they are attending as full time student (12 credit hours) by August 1st to the Alumni Foundation. **Student must maintain a 2.75 or higher GPA and other scholarship criteria to be awarded the second semester funds. (See below.)**

***MUST send schedule of spring semester to show full time student (12 or more credit hours) along with grades from first semester.***
